For over 45 years, the YES (Youth Excellence Society) has worked to build the skill-set and resiliency of youth all across British Columbia through in-school and out-of-school programming. Our programs focus on building the skills necessary for youth to grow into co-operative leaders, able to collaborate and communicate by building and contributing to effective teams. YES programs emphasize the importance of integrity and inclusion through social emotional learning (SEL), and critical and creative thinking. Grounded in the cooperative movement, we offer a variety of leadership training programs and several workshops designed for summer camps, the classroom and professional workplaces.

### **ABOUT THE BOARD POSITIONS**

With a focus on growth and expansion, The YES is seeking volunteer board members with passion for youth leadership development and the co-operative sector to join our team. Here are the requirements and assets for the positions:

- Meetings (currently held virtually) are held quarterly. Including time to review documents, each meeting requires approximately 2 hours of time.
- The YES Board has dedicated seats set aside for YES Alumni, representatives from BC's Education System, and representatives from the co-op and credit union system. There are additional board seats that don't require that you fit into any of the aforementioned categories.
- Currently The YES is looking for volunteer board members with expertise in Communication and Marketing; Fundraising; Economic Investment and Growth, and Connections in the Credit Union sector.
- In addition to quarterly board meetings, board members are asked to volunteer their expertise to work with the Executive Director, Program Director or other Board Members on strategic planning and the implementation of strategic priorities. This does not come with a specific time commitment, but is something The YES relies on for continued growth and success.
- Board positions are available in 1, 2 and 3 year terms.
